INCIDENT RESPONSE

The following guidelines are official Team Oregon policy as of January 17, 2025. This policy will be added to the Policy Manual in 2026.

If a student drops a motorcycle or is otherwise involved in an incident that may have caused injury, follow these steps:

1. Secure the scene
 - Whistle if necessary
 - Engine cut-off switch
 - Get help to remove motorcycle if needed
2. Assess the student
 - Ask student if they are injured or have any pain
 - Observe for obvious injury or signs of pain
 - Offer first aid or call EMS as necessary
3. For major injuries call EMS immediately. Examples:
 - Heavy bleeding
 - Broken bone
 - Unconscious or incoherent
4. If the rider chooses to continue training, discuss first:
 - Causation – Ask student what they think caused the incident; provide feedback on what actually happened
 - Coaching – Offer coaching to avoid similar incidents
 - Confirmation – Review risk of injury; student confirms they accept injury risk
5. Complete Incident Report (IR) if injury, disclosure of pain or \$250 property damage
6. Call On-Call to report injury or medical transport
7. Ride motorcycle to confirm operational and no repairs are needed
